



SYNOPSIS



Nora couldn't be more excited. After taking time off since graduation because of her mom's passing, she's finally ready to start living, and set off on a new adventure. That is, until her father, Sam, drops the ultimate bombshell; Everything is going to have to wait. He needed the money set aside for a 'sure fire' 'can't lose' investment and her dreams will have to sit on the shelf just a little while longer.

In a nearby town, a hoarder house was abandoned and ultimately foreclosed. With no trace of the previous owner in site, the bank is desperate to sell, but in order to do so, everything inside the house needs to be removed. With the condition that he has 2 weeks to get everything out, Sam buys the contents using Nora's money and prays for a win-fall.

Nora, Sam and Nora's younger brother Austin arrive at the home - each desperate to get this over with as soon as possible.

But what none of them know is that the previous owner, Albert Burns, was suspected of murdering his wife and child, and disappeared right before his conviction.

Shortly after their arrival, Nora finds a video recording from Albert, and figures out there is more to the story, and much more to the house. And while some may think the video tape is the ramblings of a mad-man, Nora isn't so sure. Especially after the family begins experiencing hauntings too.

Now, with their 2-week deadline looming and the house becoming increasingly more active paranormally, Nora must find the remainder of the tapes and piece together the mystery of what happened to Albert and his family, while hopefully saving her own.

Tape 6 is a self-contained gripping thriller/horror with limited cast and a mystery that will leave the audience guessing right up until the end.

THE DIRECTOR



DAVID LANGLOIS

Born in Windsor, Ontario during the mid 70's, David was as much influenced by the films of that period as by growing up in the shadow of Detroit City. It was in his early teens that he was given a camera, triggering a series of skateboarding films that put him in the director's chair at age 14.

After completing an Advertising degree, and graduating from Vancouver Film School, he quickly directed two feature length films back-to-back, both receiving international distribution. Wanting to further spread his creative wings, David moved into the world of commercials and music videos helming over 100 projects for several international recording artists and brands and giving both mediums his cinematic visual flair.

David most recently directed the feature film "Sorority Shark Attack" starring Robert Carradine for Andromedia Distribution and is scheduled for a summer 2026 theatrical release.

SAM MCGRATH





THE WRITER


ERIN HAZLEHURST
